

The following supplies are recommended for every student in second grade. We recognize that many families enjoy shopping for school supplies as part of the back-to-school tradition.

If you choose to donate the items listed below, they will be gratefully accepted by your teacher and distributed throughout the year.

The following supplies are recommended:

- 1 zippered pencil pouch (labeled with your child's name) with the following items inside:
 - o 1 white hi-polymer eraser
 - o 1 black Sharpie marker
- Personal headphones or earbuds, small enough to fit inside desk (labeled with your child's name)
- Composition notebook, wide ruled (labeled with your child's name)
- 8 Elmer's or Uhu glue sticks (not purple)
- 1 package of magic erasers
- 1 box of Kleenex

Please note, contributions are voluntary and all students will be provided all necessary supplies regardless of whether a donation is made.

The following items are optional shared supplies you may wish to donate to enhance our program:

- Black dry erase markers (thin)
- Astrobrights colored paper
- White cardstock
- White copy paper
- Sandwich, snack, quart, or gallon size Ziploc baggies
- Baby Wipes
- Sanitizing Wipes
- Crayola colored pencils, regular (12 count) or Twistables (18 count)

We also recommend having a set of supplies at home for homework. Please write your child's name on his/her backpack, lunch pail, and all outer clothing items so we can ensure their timely return if lost.

- Backpacks should be able to hang on a hook or fit in a cubby, but they may not have wheels. (No ZUCA or rolling backpacks!)
- You may wear a regular watch in second grade if you'd like to, but cell phone watches should be left at home.
