

# Fourth Grade Supply List

## 2021-2022

Contributions are voluntary, and all students will have access to the materials listed below, regardless of whether or not a donation is made. If students are in need of supplies, the teachers will have supplies available to use in the classroom.

The fourth grade team recommends the following supplies for every student in fourth grade. Many families enjoy shopping for school supplies as part of the back to school tradition. If you choose to purchase the supplies listed and donate them to the classroom, they will be gratefully accepted.

### **NO ROLLING BACKPACKS- No Zucas or backpacks with wheels**

#### **Label with student's name:**

- white, hi-polymer eraser
- 1 small school supply/pencil box for your desk  
(large boxes or boxes with locks will not be allowed.)
- 1- **one-inch**, three-ring binder WHITE ONLY- no large binders
- 1 pack of binder tabs (5 tabs with write-on dividers)
- 1 double pocket folder for homework (Choose something fun!)
- 1 box of colored pencils (12 count or less)
- 4 plain, double pocket folders: 1-green, 1-blue, 1-red, 1-yellow
- 2 single-subject spiral notebooks (about 75 or 100 pages) **WIDE-RULED ONLY**
- 1 dry erase eraser (or clean sock to use as eraser)
- 1 pair of school scissors for upper grades
- 1 hand-held pencil sharpener with a shaving collector
- 1 pair of earbuds or headphones for Chromebooks (no gaming headsets)

#### **General Classroom Supply Donations:**

- pencils- #2 (Dixon Ticonderoga)- sharpened
- ballpoint pens: 1-green, 1-blue, 1-black
- **fine point BLACK** dry erase markers
- ream of white cardstock
- ream of Astrobright colored paper
- reams of white copy paper
- large boxes of tissues
- wipes

We recommend having a similar set of supplies at home for homework.
